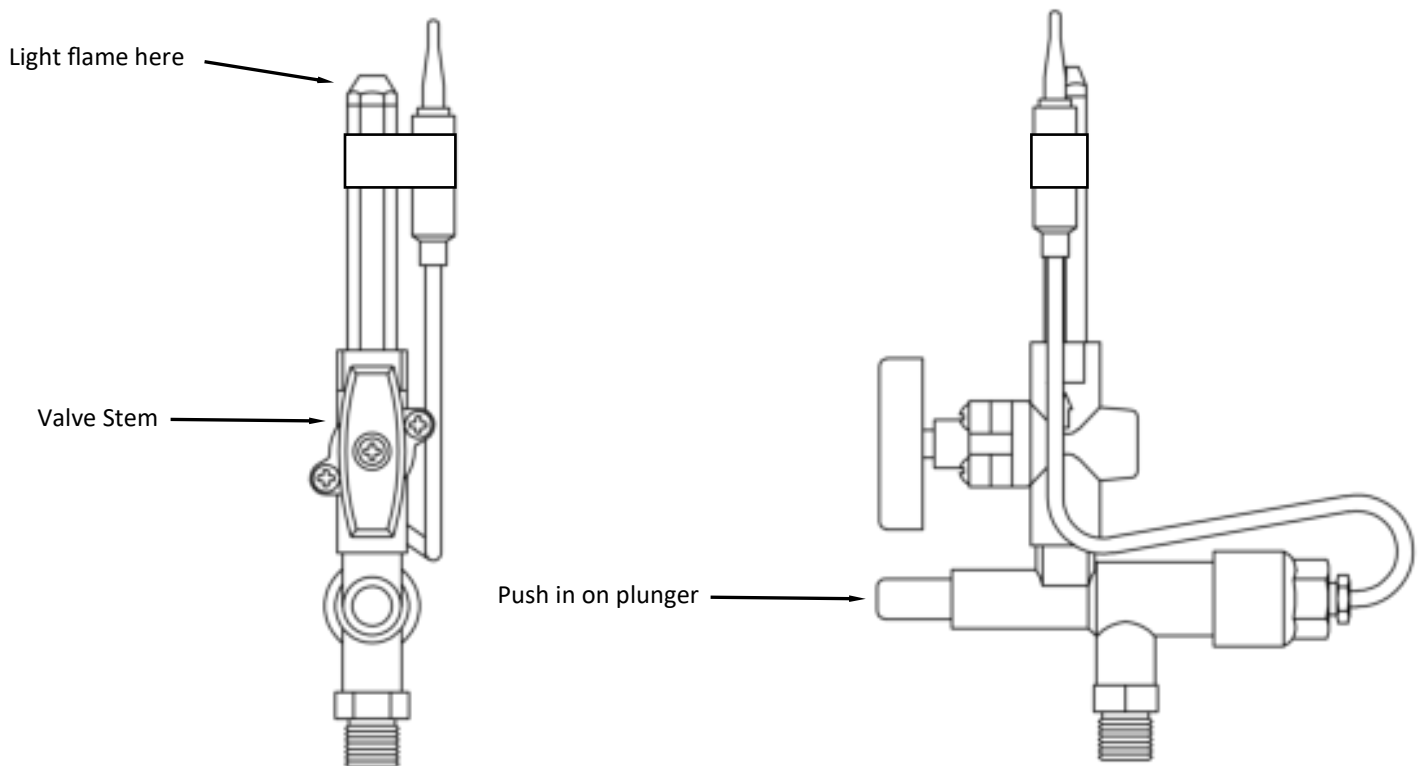


the Coppersmith

Operating and Lighting instructions for Automatic Shut-off Valve. (ASV-1)

All Coppersmith lanterns that are supplied with an ASV-1 are also supplied with a gas pressure regulator. The ASV-1 and the gas pressure regulator are both installed in the lantern by our technicians and have been tested for proper operation.

1. Make sure the main gas supply to the lantern is turned on. This will not be on the lantern .
2. Depress the valve stem inside the lantern and rotate it to the vertical or on position.
3. Depress the plunger while using a long stem lighter to light the flame. Hold the plunger in for 3 to 5 seconds, release the plunger and the flame will stay lit.
4. If the flame is extinguished for any reason, the valve on the ASV-1 will close automatically halting the flow of gas.
5. Follow steps 1 through 3 to re-set the thermocouple.
